Take part in a high-tech, historic tour through Pembina and Walsh County, located in the northeast corner of North Dakota.

This corner of the state is home to the earliest settlers, fur traders, and native peoples of what would become Dakota Territory and, ultimately, the state of North Dakota.

Geocaches have been hidden in historical locations within each county. When you find a geocache, record the GC code, date, and passport code found within the geocache container. After you find and record at least five (5) geocaches in each county, you can turn in your passport to receive that county's commemorative pathtag, which can be registered at www.pathtags.com. To earn both a Pembina and a Walsh County pathtag, you must find five (5) geocaches in each county.

Passports can be dropped off, mailed, or emailed to Icelandic State Park in Pembina County or Tracy Laaveg in Walsh County.
